# The Scottish Beagle Club

### JUDGING LISTS - 2014 - Criteria - Inclusion on any list is at the discretion of the standing Committee

#### A1 List -

For persons who have previously been approved by The Kennel Club to award CCs in the breed and have completed their first appointment and have the support of the Scottish beagle Club.

### A2 List -

For persons who fulfil all the requirements for the A3 list and who have been assessed in accordance with Kennel Club requirements and accepted by The Kennel Club for inclusion on an A2 list and have the support of the Scottish Beagle Club.

### A3 List (Breed Specialists) -

- To have been actively exhibiting Beagles for at least 10 years and have a minimum of 7 years judging experience and have the support of the Club;
- To have judged 50 breed classes at Open or Championship Shows without CC's with an adequate geographical spread, and having had a minimum of 160 dogs present. A Breed Club Show is essential;
- To be the owner or breeder of at least 3 beagles when they obtained their 1<sup>st</sup> entry in the Kennel Club Stud Book (save in exceptional circumstances);
- To have attended at least 1 Breed Specific seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/ or assessment where applicable;
- To have stewarded for 12 days at shows;
- To have attended a Seminar given by a Kennel Club accredited trainer, and passed the relevant examinations on Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures.
- To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on Conformation and Movement
- To have attended a Conformation & Movement "Hands-on Assessment" conducted by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the assessment

### A3 List (Non Specialists) -

To have a minimum of 7 years judging experience in any one breed to include 5 years in this breed and have the support of the Club;

 To have judged the breed with an adequate geographical spread. A Breed Club Show is essential;

## N.B. As from 1.9.97 a class is required to have a minimum of 2 dogs present.

- To have judged 50 classes of Beagles and at least 160 dogs, also to have awarded CC's in at least one other breed;
- To have attended at least 1 breed/judging seminar on Beagles, and to have passed one formal examination.
- To have attended a Confirmation & Movement "Hands-on Assessment" conducted by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the assessment.

### B List (Breed Specialists) -

- To have 5 years experience owning and exhibiting in this breed;
- To have judged 15 classes of this breed at 5 or more Limit, Open Shows or Championship Shows without CC's, with a minimum of 45 dogs present;
- To have attended 1 Beagle breed/judging seminar.
- To have stewarded several times at Open or Championship shows.
- To have attended a Confirmation & Movement "Hands-on Assessment" conducted by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the assessment.

### B List (Non Specialists) -

- To have a minimum 5 years judging experience in any one breed and have the support of the Club;
- To have judged 15 classes of this breed at 5 or more Open Shows or Championship Shows without CC's, with a minimum of 50 dogs present;
- To have attended 1 Beagle breed/judging seminar;
- To have stewarded several times at Open or Championship shows.
- To have attended a Confirmation & Movement "Hands-on Assessment" conducted by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the assessment.

### C List (Breed Specialists)-

For aspirant judges who have shown an interest in the breed and have the support of the Scottish Beagle Club.

### C List (Non Specialists)-

For aspirant judges who have shown an interest in the breed and have the support of the Scottish Beagle Club.
