MPD (2)

1 Lewis' Fallowfield Fellman Very promising 6month old tri. Balanced with good angulation, excellent head and soft expression and moved with drive.

2 Firth's Nictoney Intuition Another 6month old with lots to like with very good head and shoulders, correctly carried stern but not quite so settled in movement today.

PD (3)

1 Craig's Davricard Gaultier a lovely quality tan & white, compact 9month old, excellent head and expression very good neck and topline and didn't put a foot wrong in movement.

2 Phillips' Lanesend Redcap Bushranger - Open marked tri with typical head and good length of neck level topline but not quite so angulated as winner.

3 Firth's Nictoney Intuition

JD (5)

1 Havard's Annavah Nickleby Compact bright tricolour with excellent head and expression, well laid shoulders into good topline and correctly carried stern, moved with drive

2 Goldberg's Rossut Villein at Molesend - Tricolour dog, pleasing head and topline, moved correctly but would prefer a slightly softer eye expression

3 Parker & Stevens' Serenaker Saltydog

ND (3)

1 Foster's Stormpasture Saddlesoap Another lovely typical t/w 10month puppy with a superb outline and not over done in any way, excellent head with dark eyes and typical soft expression, just the correct amount of bone and excellent feet and moved with confidence
(RCC, RBIS, BPIS)

2 Findlay's Rhiconich Code Tri dog just a slightly larger mould than the winner, mild expression, good bone and feet, level topline, not quite sure of himself today.

3 Firth's Nictoney Intuition

GD (1)

1 Starbrook, Hunt & Norris' Koorbrats Highwayman - compact tricolour with very pleasing head and front, dark pigmentation moved with drive.

PGD (4, 1 abs)

1 Fallon's Newlin Rambler AW(S) 4yr old tan & white with an excellent outline, typical head and expression, good topline and well carried stern, moved true.

2 Lewis' Fallowfield Channing - open tri and well up to size, compact with good topline and well carried stern but too much stop for me spoiling his expression.

3 Jones' Molesend Colt.

LD (5)

- 1 Kingsland's Redcap Doctor Strange - tricolour with a very nice topline, soft expression, good bone and feet and excellent turn of stifle and moved with drive.
- 2 Diamond & Carruthers' Jalhar Fame N Fortune from Kelcardi - Very pleasing tricolour with excellent outline, good expression, neat feet and well carried stern.
- 3 Findlay's Rhiconich Obconica

OD (5)

- 1 Parker & Stevens' Ch Serenaker Armani This 2yr old tri really stood out today, ideal size, excellent head and expression, compact without being "cloddy";, correct bone, excellent neck and shoulders and just flew round the ring (CC & BIS)
- 2 Jones' Ch Newlin Preston to Clairdale JW ShCM This 5yr old is another worthy champion. Well handled to show off this tricolour's excellent outline. He has a lovely head and expression and a fine topline and stern.
- 3 Henningsson-Dundas' Julemark Luther.

VD (3) An interesting class with none of the three entries tricolour!

- 1 Hunt's Ch Shercroft Apollo JW ShCM 81/2yr old with an excellent head and typical expression with correct dark eyes; good front and feet, excellent topline and stern carriage, moved well.
- 2 Kingsland & Stevens' Ch Redcap The Patriot 7+yr lemon & white with dog has a lovely head and expression. Feet and front are excellent and he carries his stern well a close decision.
- 3 English's Gempeni Paso.

BITCHES

MPB (5, 1 abs)

- 1 Tanner's Felinoak Ffansi Nansi A mature 8month old lovely tri puppy. Excellent length of neck, feminine head with dark eyes, good length of leathers front and topline are excellent and she carries her stern well.
- 2 Firth's Nictoney Gingerbread - tan & white with a lovely soft expression, dark pigmentation with level topline - just needs some more ring experience.
- 3 Brownlow's Rushwater Violet Sky.

PB (4)

- 1 Havard's Dufosee Julianna avec Annavah - a lovely T&W with a delightful head with well set-leathers and lovely expression and dark appealing eyes and excellent pigmentation. Good bone and turn of stifle and moved with drive.
- 2 Firth's Nictoney Gingerbread,
- 3 Lennard's Butterow Unity.

JB (7)

- 1 Craig's Annavah Belinda of Davricard well matured tricolour young lady. Compact and with excellent head and dark eyes. Topline good and moved well front and rear with excellent stern carriage.
- 2 Henningsson-Dundas' Julemark Persephone -Tri with lovely expression, good front and feet, topline fine, and good angulation.
- 3 Binks' Tannahill Zola.

NB (4, 1 abs)

1 Firth's Nictoney Gingerbread.

2 Matthew's Carvaha Fire N Ice - tricolour bitch with a good outline and topline, typical head and good coat and stern carriage.

3 Brownlow's Rushwater Violet Sky.

GB (2)

1 McBain & Steven's Blitzlilie Girl With No Name 4 1/2 yr old tan & white - well built with good head and topline, excellent bone and feet and moved with drive.

2 Kilgour's Kelcardi Claudia - unplaced in Junior but a good type of hound with fine topline and stern carriage but not quite the soft expression of winner.

PGB (7, 1 abs)

1 Hunt's Dufosee Iyla at Bondlea JW - smart tricolour with a lovely soft expression, good stop, topline and length of neck, movement excellent with well carried stern.

2 Tanner's Felinoak El Koko Loko - very smart open marked tricolour with excellent head and expression, good laid shoulders and moves with drive but just carrying a little extra weight today.

3 Bink's Tannahill Zia.

LB (11, 1 abs)

1 Goldberg's Molesend Dormouse JW Lovely type of tan & white bitch, excellent compact outline with head in correct proportions, appealing expression with sufficient stop and depth of muzzle, good neck and shoulders moved with drive. Hope its not too long before she is awarded her 3rd CC. ([BCC & BOS](#))

2 Arden's Annavah Star Above Madika AW(B) Open marked tri with a great personality! Very good head and expression, excellent neck and shoulders and can certainly cover the ground well when she puts her mind to it.

3 Foster's Stormpasture Rockette.

OB (7) A class of quality

1 Parker & Stevens' Ch Serenaker Maid In America - a real showgirl and didn't put a foot wrong. Correct size, compact tricolour with an excellent feminine head and kind expression, good depth of body, well ribbed and carried her stern as required both standing and on the move. ([RBCC](#))

2 Havard's Ch Annavah Princess Tiana - another excellent type from this kennel, compact tricolour, excellent bone, good topline and well carried stern, moved with drive.

3 Deans' Gempeni Cornflower.

VB (8, 1 abs)

1 Arden's Madika Spot On JW ShCM AW(P) VW) 8yr old veteran - a lovely open marked tricolour - a very soft expression and excellent topline and certainly moves with drive - or was she looking for a sausage! A real character ([BVIS](#))

2 Parker & Stevens' Ch Serenaker Elle's Belles - compact 8yr old excellent head with dark eyes, good shoulders and angulation and in excellent condition.

3 Fraser's Wyvisview Harlequin.
